RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All riders must collect a minimum of \$50 in pledges to participate.
2. A current original **Negative Coggins Paper** or certified copy must be presented for each horse. This is required by Florida State Law and will be strictly enforced.
3. The Trail Boss and his designated wranglers will be in charge of the train at all times.
4. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the premises.
5. NO DOGS OR PETS OF ANY KIND.
6. NO STALLIONS-NO EXCEPTIONS!
7. Kicking horses must have a red ribbon on their tails. Red ribbons will be available at registration.
8. No riding double, bareback riding or ponying horses during the ride.
9. Littering will not be tolerated (including cigarette butts and hay string). Remember that we are guests on private property. Damage to trail areas, or any other private property will not be tolerated.
10. Ride at your own risk! We suggest riders under 15 wear impact protected head gear while riding
